## Plains Public Schools #1 Notice of Intent to Impose an Increase in Levies

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Plains Public Schools #1 Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Plains Public Schools #1 Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district:

- 3. Update the heating system in the third and fourth grade classrooms.
